



OCMC Votes on Rules and Reports and Recommendations

September 10, 2015

The Ohio Constitutional Modernization Commission held a full Commission meeting on September 10, 2015 in the Riffe Center for Government and the Arts.

Jeff Jacobson, vice-chair of the Bill of Rights and Voting Committee, presented the first reading on two no change reports and recommendations for Article I, Section 13 (Quartering Troops) and Article I, Section 17 (No Hereditary Privileges). The reports and recommendations will be presented for a second time at the next full Commission meeting slated for October 8, 2015.

Mark Wagoner, chair of the Organization and Administration Committee, presented amended Rules of Procedure and Conduct, aimed at speeding up the timeline for adopting reports and recommendations that recommend no change be made to existing constitutional provisions. The amended rules had been passed on to the full Commission after a unanimous vote from the Organization and Administration committee earlier that day. The Rules of Procedure and Conduct were adopted.
